Meeting was called to order at 4:35pm by Gayle, our President.

Guild Current Business:

VP Communications Update

Elizabeth will post one more Red, White, and Blue quilts post next Monday. She has received two emails inquiring about our Zoom meeting, looking to the IEMQG as a model. She commends our guild for doing things well in this time of distancing.

Treasurer

Candy distributed the monthly financial statements by email earlier today.

Candy gave a brief summary of the e-mail.

New activity included payments of \$40 to Elizabeth and \$21.17 pending for Spoonflower labels.

Discussion about collection of dues for 2020 will be put on a future agenda.

Opportunity Quilt

Gayle is working on the binding for the Opportunity quilt and has plans to take it to a vineyard for a photo shoot.

Charity

Gayle has batting available for charity quilts. Some of it is fusible. There are a variety of sizes, mostly smaller, lap sizes, with some larger pieces. This batting is available free to members making charity quilts. Contact Gayle with your charity quilt size and she will find a batting piece for you.

Laura has not had any requests for charity quilt kits. She will bring some to the virtual meeting for Candy and anyone else who is interested.

Spoonflower order for labels

The order will yield approximately 150 quilt labels.

Gayle currently has about 10 labels, which she will bring to Laura at the August meeting, for the charity kits.



Programs

Program Chairs will send a blast Tuesday, reminding members to submit Show and Share quilts for our August Virtual meeting.

Candy reminded us that next June will be our 5th anniversary. She suggested we give members a 5-year pin. She also recently attended a scarf dying event in Huntington Beach. She thinks our guild could host a similar event, possibly dying fat quarters. She believes it could be done with COVID 19 safety practices, perhaps in her garage. She will research the costs and other details and present to the board.

Laura will have a new Block of the Month ready for September.

Plans for August 1, 2020 Zoom guild meeting

Laura will send an invitation to the meeting July 21, morning. She will send the link a second time Friday afternoon.

Members need to submit Show and Share and Strawberry BOM photos the Wednesday before the meeting.

Gayle, Laura, Pat, Candy, and Kim will assemble at Gayle's office in Ontario for the Zoom meeting. Others are invited if interested.

Laura is ready with a half hour power point presentation about binding. During the presentation members can submit questions in the chat function. Laura will answer them at the end. Laura plans to include a survey or poll during her presentation. She will prepare and practice it before the meeting.

SCCQG Update

Laura sent an e-mail with links to websites that have information about Virtual Meetings. There is also a link to an upcoming Meet the Teachers virtual event on August 4-5.

Laura shared information garnered from SCCQG about running a virtual meeting. Tips include: Make sure you have more than one host, make sure you "pin" items for everyone to see them, come early and help members get comfortable, don't charge guest fees, put business items at the end of the meeting, use the mute button to avoid people interrupting the meeting, and if you charge for a speaker/class make sure there is a limit of two people per computer. Laura indicated Zoom requires a password or waiting room to enter the meeting. Elizabeth added that the password can be imbedded in the link.

SCCQG's insurance will pay for officer's errors and omissions. Also, you can notify 2 weeks prior to hold a "parking lot" board meeting, and it will be covered by insurance.

SCCQG is collecting quilts for Road 2 CA SCCQG Special Exhibit. The theme is, "Sharing Our Quilts," and they are due November 1.

SCCQG Meet the Teachers meeting is rescheduled April 2021. The next meeting is in October 2020.
