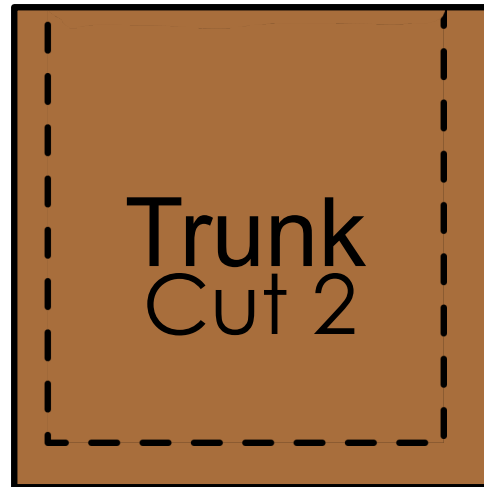
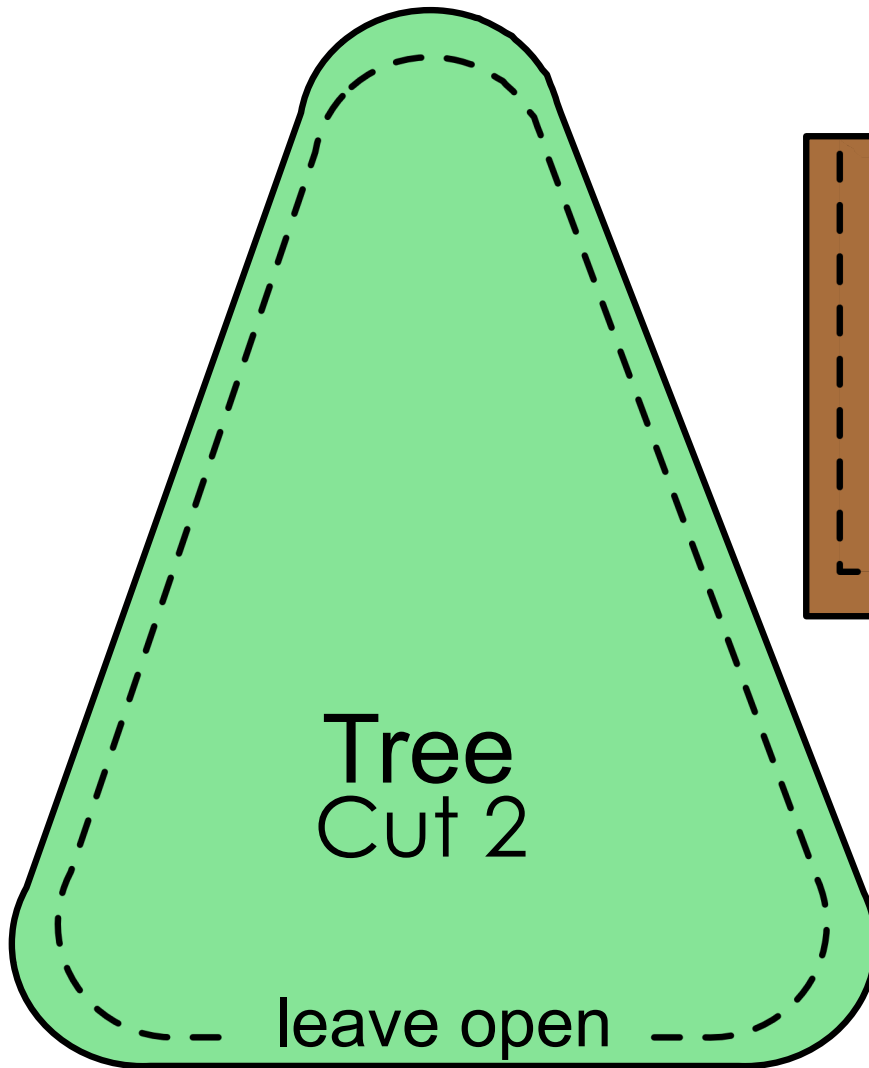




Ornaments from IEMQG 2020



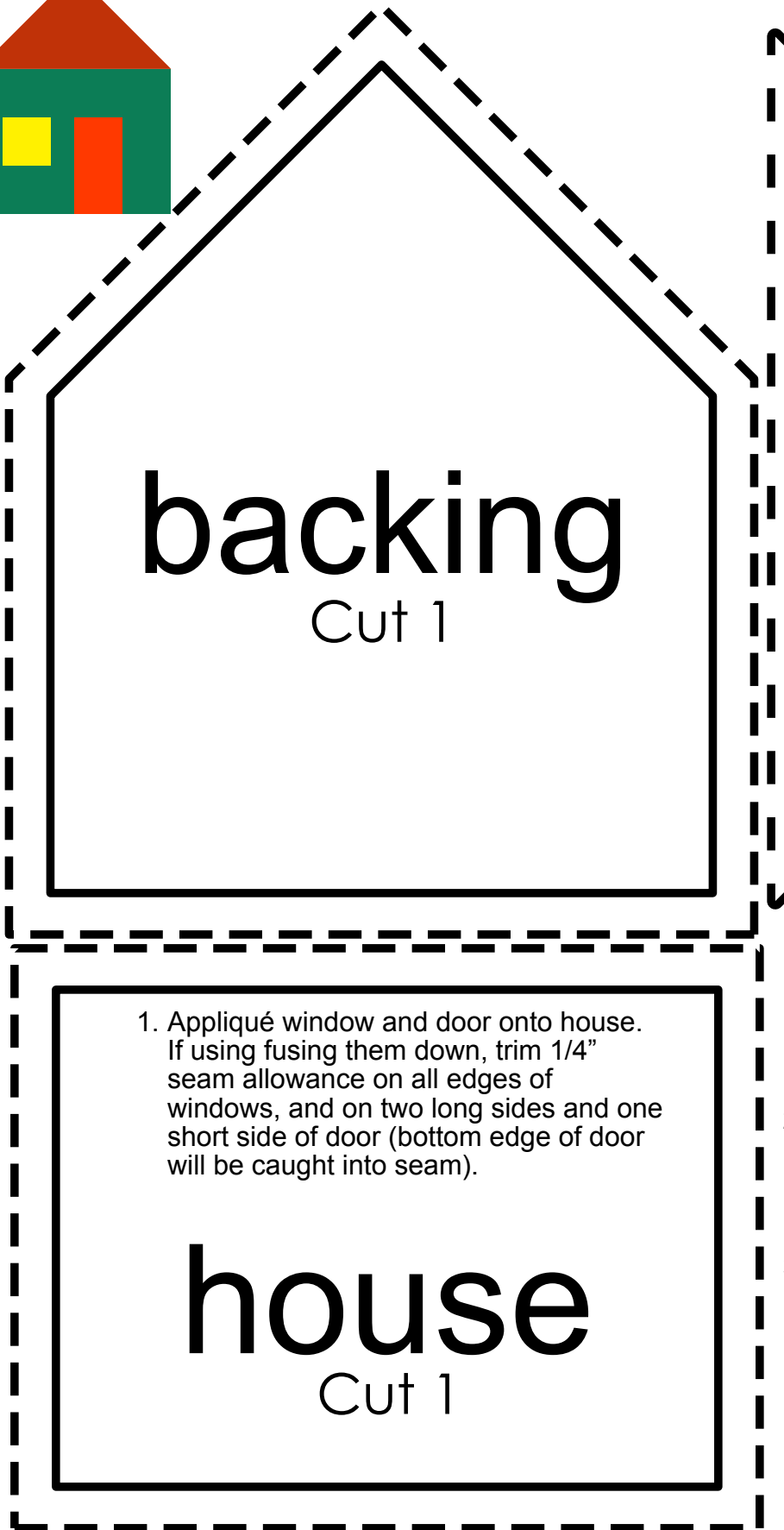
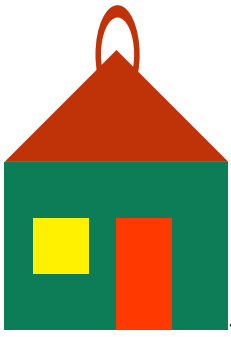
Cut out tree, stitch (leaving opening on lower edge), stuff.

Cut out trunk, sew RST together, also leaving an opening to turn. Topstitch on three edges, and insert into tree's opening.

Whipstitch closed. Sew trim onto tree, in garland style, as shown in photo.



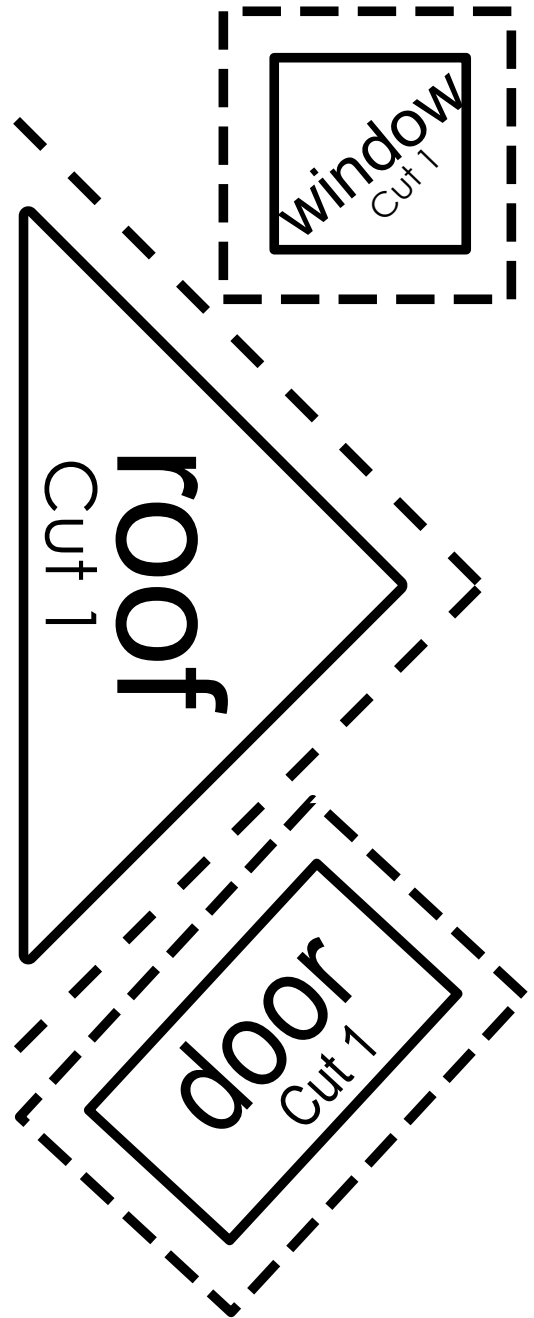

1. Appliqué window and door onto house. If using fusing them down, trim 1/4" seam allowance on all edges of windows, and on two long sides and one short side of door (bottom edge of door will be caught into seam).

2. Sew roof onto house. Press. If desired, pin a 3" folded length of ribbon to rooftop, raw edges aligned with raw edges of roof.
3. Sew backing onto house unit, leaving an 2" opening to turn. Turn, stuff, then whipstitch the opening closed.

String a garland, alternating houses and trees. Happy Decorating from IEMQG!
