## IEMQG QuiltCon Community Outreach Quilt Directions

We are making "square-in-a-square" blocks using improvisation. For consistency, the middle square should be centered both vertically and horizontally. Blocks will be trimmed to $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ by Lynn and Patti. The inside square should be no bigger than $2^{\prime \prime}$ finished. We are asking members to do the following.

## SEWING:

## Start with a square or rectangular center piece with sides no smaller than 1.25 " and no larger than 2.5".



## Add similar sized pieces on either side to make a rectangle no narrower than

 1.25 " tall and at least
3.5" wide.

Add similar sized strips on top and bottom to increase the $\quad 3.5$ min. height to not less than 3.5".


## RULES:

1. Make your block larger than 3.5 " square.
2. Center the middle square or rectangle.
3. Use contrast between the middle square and outer square.
4. Press outward.
5. Do not trim to $3.5^{\prime \prime}$. Trimming will be done by Lynn or Patti
